VETERANS COURT RULES AND CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

- Appear for judicial reviews as directed by the court or probation. You must be on time.
- Stay in contact with your probation officer and attend all scheduled appointments with your probation officer.
- Call your Probation Officer within 48 hours of sentencing and/or release from custody at 612-348-9225.
- Do not use alcoholic beverages, non-prescribed drugs, or any substance listed on the ETG Agreement.
- Submit to random drug and alcohol testing as directed by probation and/or law enforcement at any time in this program.
- Complete treatment, therapy, or programming as directed by the Veterans Court Team.
- You must take all medications as prescribed.
- You are only allowed to use one hospital, one prescribing primary physician, one psychiatrist or mental health professional (if needed) and one pharmacy.
- You cannot reside anywhere a firearm is present.

Note: Participants who are absent from the Veterans Court program for more than 60 days are suspended. Participants are terminated from Veterans Court if absent more than one year. Your Veterans Court Participant Handbook contains additional information about these and other Veterans Court conditions.

PROBATION RULES

It is your responsibility to follow all of these rules of the Hennepin County Department of Community Corrections and Rehabilitation Adult Field Services ("Probation" or "AFS") and stay in contact. If you have any question about these rules or the conditions of your probation, contact your Probation Officer.

1. Call your Probation Officer within 72 hours of sentencing and/or release from custody. If you do not have the name and number of your Probation Officer, call Probation Intake (612-348-2110) or email POconnect@hennepin.us for further instructions.
2. Submit to the electronic and/or physical search of your person and/or premises upon the request of a Probation Officer per the search and seizure policies of the Department of Community Corrections and Rehabilitation.
3. Report any arrests, charges, or contacts with law enforcement to your Probation Officer within 72 hours.
4. Meet with your Probation Officer as your Probation Officer directs.
5. Keep your Probation Officer informed of your current address, telephone number and employment.
6. Do not move from Minnesota unless you have the permission of your Probation Officer and you comply with all the rules of the "receiving state." Your Probation Officer can help you complete the required forms.
7. Provide verification of your participation in, and completion of, required services, programs, or evaluations.

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
