The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 - Not Small Amount Marijuana

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(1), with reference to: 609.101.3, 152.025.4(b)

Maximum Sentence: 5 YEARS AND/OR \$3,000-\$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/06/2019

Control #(ICR#): 19269447

Charge Description: That on or about 9/6/2019, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, JACOB MAMAR JOHNSON unlawfully possessed one or more mixtures containing a Schedule I, II, III, or IV controlled substance, to-wit: methamphetamine.



STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On September 6, 2019, officers were dispatched to a welfare check at 4998 Lake Street East in Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota.

Upon arrival, officers located a male matching the caller's description, later identified as JACOB MAMAR JOHNSON aka JACOB LAWRENCE ZELINSKI, Defendant herein, sitting under the Lake Street bridge. Officers approached Defendant and observed needles, a lighter, rubber straps, and glass pipes laying on the ground surrounding Defendant. Among these items, officers observed one needle that was loaded with suspected narcotics.

Officers placed Defendant under arrest for drug paraphernalia. Officers asked if Defendant had any more paraphernalia on his person. Defendant said he did not, but that he "found some bindles down there," referring to his campsite.

In a search incident to arrest, officers located a piece of papers with suspected narcotics in Defendant's pants pocket.

The needle contained 38 units of a mixture that tested positive for methamphetamine.

Defendant has prior Chapter 152 convictions, including MNCIS Case. No. 27-CR-18-2728. Defendant has several active warrants (MNCIS #27-CR-18-2728; 27-CR-19-16799; 27-CR-19-3023). Therefore, the State respectfully requests that his Complaint issue by warrant.
