





### STANDARD PROBATION CONDITIONS

It is your responsibility to follow all of these conditions of probation and rules of the Hennepin County Department of Community Corrections and Rehabilitation Adult Field Services ("Probation"). If you have any questions about these conditions of your probation or the rules of Probation, contact your Probation Officer. If you do not have the name and number of your Probation Officer, call Probation Intake (612-348-2110) or email [POconnect@hennepin.us](mailto:POconnect@hennepin.us) for further instructions.

1. Follow all State and Federal criminal laws.
2. Contact your probation officer as directed.
3. Tell your Probation Officer within 72 hours if you have contact with law enforcement.
4. Tell your Probation Officer within 72 hours if you are charged with any new crime.
5. Tell your Probation Officer within 72 hours if you change your address, employment, or telephone number.
6. Cooperate with the search of your person, residence, vehicle, workplace, property, and things as directed by your probation officer.
7. Sign releases of information as directed.
8. Do not possess any firearm, ammunition, or explosives.
