COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Assault-2nd Degree-Dangerous Weapon-Substantial Bodily Harm

Minnesota Statute: 609.222.2, with reference to: 609.222.2, 609.11.5(a), 609.101.2

Maximum Sentence: 10 YEARS AND/OR \$6,000-\$20,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 06/01/2022

Control #(ICR#): 22019582

Charge Description: That on or about June 1, 2022, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, LAMAR GLASS, assaulted victim and inflicted substantial bodily harm, while using a firearm.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On June 1, 2022, Brooklyn Park Police responded to a shooting call at the Huntington Park Apartments, City of Brooklyn Park, Hennepin County, Minnesota.

Officers arrived and located Victim, an adult male, in the stairwell. Officers moved Victim to be in a better position to provide medical aid. Officers noted Victim's right leg was bleeding heavily and could see an entrance and exit wound from a bullet. It appeared that Victim's shin bone was broken. Officers applied a tourniquet to stop the bleeding.

From surveillance footage, it was learned that Victim was dragged out of apartment 222 by 2 individuals. Officers learned several individuals were inside of this apartment and obtained a search warrant. Once inside of the apartment, Officers did observe a sandal filled with a blood like substance.

Victim was taken to North Memorial Medical Center for treatment and was not immediately able to provide a statement to law enforcement. When Victim became more oriented, he provided a description of the shooter as a black male with a shaved head and a scar under his eye who came out of nowhere.

Detective Angerhofer review additional security footage from the apartment and observed individuals who entered and exited apartment 222.

Detective Angerhofer took a statement from Witness 1. Witness 1 identified Antwan Lamar Due, (D.O.B. 12-15-1976), aka Lamar Glass Defendant herein, as the shooter. Witness 1 said he and Victim went to see Defendant to buy cocaine. Witness 1 said they were all sitting together at the table and Defendant appeared to be high or drunk and had a gun in his hand. Victim was talking "smack" to Defendant. Defendant shot Victim. Victim slumped over in his chair. Defendant told some of the people in the apartment to drag Victim out of the apartment. Witness 1 said Defendant gave the gun to someone else who lives in the apartment complex.

Detective Angerhofer then spoke with Witness 2 who was on the lease of Apartment 222. Witness 2 said Defendant shot Victim. Witness 2 believes it was an accident because Defendant would not do anything like that.

Detective Angerhofer then took a Mirandized statement from Defendant. Defendant is a black male with a shaved head and a scar under his eye. Defendant said he did not remember what happened last night because he was drunk and asleep. Defendant denied having a gun.

Defendant is in custody.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

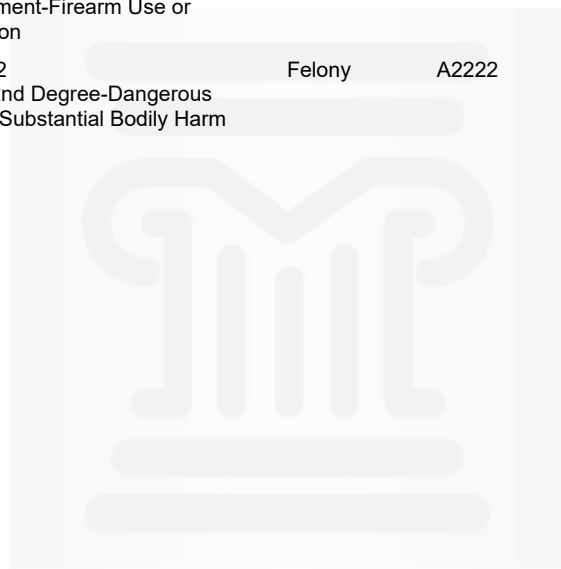
