**COMPLAINT**

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT II****Charge: ASSAULT-4TH DEG-PEACE OFFICER-PHYSICALLY ASSAULTS-G**

Minnesota Statute: 609.2231.1(b)

Maximum Sentence: 0-1 year and/or \$0-\$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 07/23/2022

Charge Description: ... did physically assault a peace officer licensed under section 626.845 Subd. 1, when said officer was effecting a lawful arrest or executing any other duty imposed by law;

**COUNT III****Charge: FLEEING A PEACE OFFICER BY A MEANS OTHER THAN A MOTOR VEHICLE**

Maximum Sentence: 0-90 days and/or \$0-\$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Charge Description: ... attempts to evade or elude a peace officer, who is acting in the lawful discharge of an official duty, by means of running, hiding, or by any other means except fleeing in a motor vehicle, for the purpose of avoiding arrest, detention, or investigation, or in order to conceal or destroy potential evidence related to the commission of a crime;

That on July 23, 2022, at approximately 1316 hours, University of Minnesota Police Officer Mortenson was dispatched to the 19th Avenue Parking ramp located at 300 19th Avenue South, in the City of Minneapolis, County of Hennepin, State of Minnesota. Officer Mortenson was directed to the second floor of the parking ramp in response to a report of a man sleeping.

Upon arrival, Officer Mortenson observed a man, later identified as the Defendant herein, RODERICK JEROME CARPENTER II (DOB: 6/20/1992), in a corner near a stairwell, lighting a glass pipe and consuming what appeared to be a narcotic. Officer Mortenson approached the Defendant and ordered him to put the pipe down and remain seated. The Defendant ignored Officer Mortenson's orders and stood up. When Officer Mortenson grabbed the Defendant's right arm, the Defendant pulled away and ran from Officer Mortenson. Officer Mortenson ran after the Defendant, made contact with his back, and the two fell to the ground. Once on the ground, the Defendant punched Officer Mortenson in the head several times and kicked him. Officer Mortenson attempted to gain control of the Defendant, but the Defendant freed himself and ran south through the parking ramp. Officer Mortenson chased the Defendant out of the parking ramp and then southwest toward the intersection of Cedar Avenue and Riverside Avenue.

During the chase, the Defendant approached a group of pedestrians and attempted to take a bike from one of them. The pedestrian pulled the bike away and the Defendant stumbled. The Defendant then pulled an object from his pocket that Officer Mortenson thought was a knife. Officer Mortenson deployed his Taser, after which the Defendant dropped the object.

Officers arrived to assist Officer Mortenson and the Defendant was placed under arrest.
