- 6. Cooperate with the search of your person, residence, vehicle, workplace, property, and things as directed by your probation officer.
- 7. Sign releases of information as directed.
- 8. Give a DNA sample when directed.
- 9. Do not use or possess any firearm, ammunition, or explosive.

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
