- Contact your probation officer as directed.
- Tell your probation officer within 72 hours if you have contact with law enforcement.
- Tell your probation officer within 72 hours if you are charged with any new crime.
- Tell your probation officer within 72 hours if you change your address, employment, or telephone number.
- Cooperate with the search of your person, residence, vehicle, workplace, property, and things as directed by your probation officer.
- Sign releases of information as directed.
- Complete Veterans Court program. Obey all rules of Veterans court. You are only allowed to use one hospital, one prescribing physician, one psychiatrist, and one pharmacy. You cannot reside anywhere a firearm is present.
- No alcohol/controlled substance use or any substance listed on the ETG agreement, with the exception of prescribed medications.
- Random testing as directed by probation and/or law enforcement at any time during the program
- Complete treatment therapy, or programming as directed by Veterans Court team
- Take medications in the prescribed dosage and frequency




