The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

### COUNT I

### Charge: Theft-Take/Drive Motor Vehicle-No Owner Consent

Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(17), with reference to: 609.52.3(3)(d)(v) Maximum Sentence: 5 YEARS AND/OR \$10,000 Offense Level: Felony

Charge Description: That on or about 2/27/2023, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, Delayna Adrianne Lussier took and/or drove a motor vehicle, a Chevy Cruz, without the consent of A.O.L. or the owner's authorized agent, and he/she knew or had reason to know that the owner or authorized agent did not give consent, and the motor vehicle had a value of less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) and the property stolen is a motor vehicle.

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On February 27, 2023 at approximately 10:12 p.m., officers with the Champlin Police Department were dispatched to a report of a vehicle theft that just occurred at a group home located on the 1500 block of Pennsylvania Ave. N., in Champlin, Hennepin County, Minnesota. A staff member at that location witnessed a resident of the group home, DELAYNA LUSSIER (DOB: 08/18/2003), steal and drive off in a staff member, A.O.L.'s vehicle, a Chevy Cruz. This was captured on video from that location.

LUSSIER was observed driving the Chevy Cruz several minutes later and was stopped in the area of 117th and Winnetka Ave. N. When LUSSIER was stopped, she noted "I stole a car."

A.O.L. noted that she has never given LUSSIER permission to take or drive the vehicle. She also noted that her purse had been on the front passenger seat of the vehicle when stolen, and that the purse had been rummaged through with \$75 missing when the vehicle was returned.


