The Court issues the order below setting mandatory time limitations. Any extensions or other changes will be made only for good cause shown by written motion supported by affidavit. Neither a conflict with other court appearances nor agreement of the parties is, by itself, good cause for extension.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. A jury trial in this matter is set for April 19th, 2021 at 9:00am.
2. The Court will not entertain a motion to continue the trial on the day of trial, unless the basis for the motion arose on the day prior or over the weekend prior.
3. The defense shall cause to be scheduled on or before **two months prior to trial** a hearing on any suppression (*Rasmussen*) motions based on constitutional grounds.
4. Motions in limine must be filed **two weeks before trial**. Responses will be due one week before trial.
5. The State shall serve and file notice of any *Spreigl* offenses sought to be admitted, and any *Blakely* notice of intent to seek an aggravated sentence, in the form required and by the deadlines set forth in Minn. R. Crim. P. 7.02 and 7.03.

Failure to raise these pretrial issues by the dates prescribed will result in these issues being deemed waived by the Court.
