COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: TRAFFIC-DL-DRIVING AFTER CANCELLATION-INIMICAL TO PUBLIC SAFETY

Minnesota Statute: 171.24.5

Maximum Sentence: 0-1 year and/or \$0-\$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

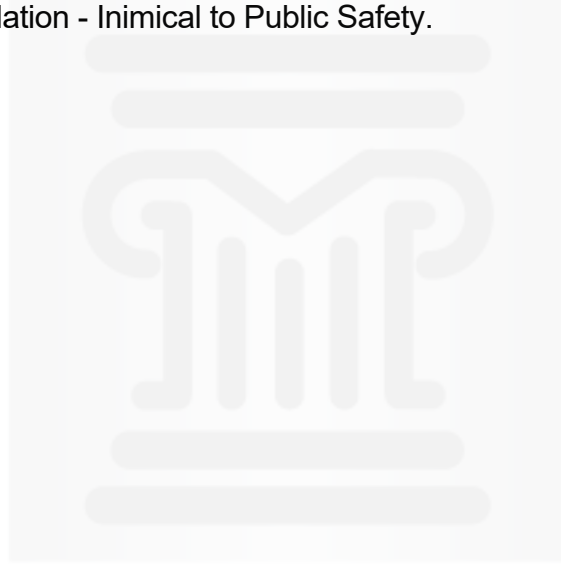

Charge Description: ... operate a motor vehicle, the operation of which requires a driver's license, at a time when his/her driver's license or driving privilege had been canceled or denied by the Commissioner of Public Safety, said cancellation or denial having been ordered pursuant to the provisions of 171.04, subd. 1(10), and defendant had notice of or reasonably should have known of the cancellation or denial;

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

That on or about March 7, 2020, Minneapolis Police Officer Doll was on routine patrol in the area of Central Avenue North and 33rd Avenue North in the City of Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota. At approximately 5:33 PM, Officer Doll observed a vehicle that appeared to be traveling above the posted speed limit of 30 MPH. Using his hand held laser radar, Officer Doll clocked the vehicle at 49 MPH and 47 MPH, where the speed was locked. Officer Doll initiated a traffic stop of the vehicle and made contact with the driver, identified by MN picture ID as Priest Jesus Dorsey (DOB: 4/7/1973), Defendant herein. Routine checks revealed Defendant's license status was cancelled - inimical to public safety. Defendant was arrested for Driving After Cancellation - Inimical to Public Safety.
