Dear Brookdale Court Administration:

I, Anne Riley, need to cancel my court hearing on January 16, 2020 at 9am as this court hearing is interrelated with my court hearing at the Anoka County Courthouse and for the following reasons. As noted in my letter dated December 4, 2019 to the Anoka County Courthouse, I submitted a letter of request to the judge asking to have the judge "set aside" the judgement from November 18, 2019 and then reschedule the court hearing. However, when the court hearing was rescheduled for January 6, 2020 all issues addressed in my December 4, 2019 letter were not addressed in the January 6, 2020 court hearing. Why is this relevant to the January 16, 2020 Court Hearing? Because on July 27, 2019, I was arrested after being citationed with Driving after Revocation and Obstruction of Justice. Why is this relevant information? My driver's license was wrongfully revoked because of governmental recordkeeping

errors that I have been trying to explain and prove through exhibits enclosed with my motions to re-open traffic citations. This information was served to both the judge and the prosecutor, before the January 6, 2020 court hearing. Furthermore, the citation payment of \$193 that I paid on 12/4/2017 and the Court Payment Center received on 12/13/2017 should have placed my driver's license into activation status, because the \$193 became revenue to the government. In other words, I paid the citation fine in order to get my driver's license activated. My license did not get activated though. Then on 1/26/2018, I was stopped by a Sheriff who asked me, if I knew that my driver's license was in suspense, I stated that I paid the fine. After receiving this citation, I looked back to my receipt from the Court Payment Center and noticed that a late payment penalty was added that I was not aware of and then paid that \$25. However, this \$25 payment was misapplied to the incorrect citation number. More importantly, my payment of \$193 has not been and even currently properly recorded in all relevant recordkeeping systems. All relevant recordkeeping systems includes; the MN Court Payment Center, the MN DVS Renewal Center, Dept of Public Safety and Police Offices recordkeeping systems. Why am I noting this here? Because the \$193 did not get properly recorded in all relevant recordkeeping systems resulting in a domino impact of seven citations more issued to me not to mention create issues for me in obtaining my car registration tabs

and auto insurance. I am being punished with citations because the government has not corrected their own record keeping errors so that payment transactions properly flow and are recorded in all relevant record keeping systems. The exhibits in my package clearly substantiate the above mentioned facts.

Therefore, I ask that you please cancel my court hearing scheduled for January 16, 2020 9am until I am able to resolve this issue with the Anoka County Courthouse.
