This matter came before the Court on a request for restitution. Based on the files and all proceedings, the Court makes the following findings and order.

1. ☐ The Court has considered the income, resources, and obligations of the defendant.  
☐ The defendant has agreed to pay restitution as set forth below.
2. The defendant must pay restitution, as a condition of probation, as follows:

4. The defendant has the right, pursuant to Minnesota Statute § 611A.045, subdivision 3(b), to object to restitution within 30 days.
  - ☐ This order is final if the defendant does not file an objection with the court within 30 days.
  - ☐ This order is final; the defendant waives the right to object.
5. Unless a minimum monthly payment or due date is established by the Court below, the full amount of restitution is due within 60 days of this order being final.
  - ☐ Pay on a schedule as directed by Probation in an amount not less than \$ \_\_\_\_\_/month starting 60 days after the order is final. The full amount of restitution must be paid at least 60 days before the end of probation.
  - ☐ Payment in full is due by \_\_\_\_\_.
6. If payment is not made according to this order or if 60 days pass with no payment being received by the court administrator, the entire amount is immediately due. The matter may be forwarded to the Minnesota Department of Revenue for collection, and a collection fee of up to 25% may be charged.
7. This order may be docketed as a civil judgment by any victim identified above (or their estate) without paying a filing fee. This order is not a substitute for the right of the victim (or their estate) to recover through other legal means.
